

THE SCHOOL DAY

School begins at 8.40am

You will line up in your form groups on the MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) and will be collected by your form teacher.

Form time takes place from 8.40 to 8.55am each day Monday to Friday. You will also have assembly in the Atrium one day per week. Lots of activities take place during form time, such as numeracy ninjas to help to improve your numeracy skills and reading to help improve your literacy skills. We also hold spelling bees and other competitions throughout the year.

GETTING TO SCHOOL

If you need to get the bus to school, it might be useful to check the timetable for the buses, and practice where to get on and off during the summer holiday.



The healthiest way to get to school is to walk or cycle, we have a bike shed where you can lock your bike up safely. Why not try, practising the route to school over the summer?

If you are arriving by car, please ensure you leave enough time to travel down Knowsley Park Lane as it can get very busy with other parents dropping off students. Another good tip is to be dropped off a short walk away from school, that way you avoid the congestion on the Lane.



WHAT HAPPENS IF.....

I AM LATE?

Don't panic, occasionally things go wrong in the morning, if something unusual has happened please contact school to let us know.

Being on time to school is very important, if you are regularly late you are missing out on valuable time in school and developing important relationships with your form and your form teacher, you will also not know what is going on in the school community

If you are late more than once in a week you will be given an after school detention to make up the missed time. If you are persistently late we will contact your parents/carer to discuss how we can support you to attend school on time

I AM ILL?

Good attendance in school is vital if you are to make the progress we expect, however we do realise that sometimes pupils will become unwell.

If you are too ill to come to school, please ask your parents to contact us first thing in the morning.

If you feel unwell whilst in school, tell your teacher or go to see Mrs Campbell in the Pastoral Homebase at either break or lunchtime

I FORGET SOMETHING?

REWARDS
